

PARENTS/GUARDIAN INFORMATION FLYER - Advice for Applicants and their Parents

The Youth ANZAAS conference/forum for science students from Years 10, 11 and 12 in Australian schools will be held from the evening of Sunday the 10th July to the morning of Friday15th July, Youth ANZAAS is organised by the Australian & New Zealand Association for the Advancement of Science (ANZAAS) in conjunction with the Royal Society of New Zealand (RSNZ).

Students will be accommodated at St Leo's College on the campus of The University of Queensland located about 7km from central Brisbane, the capital city of Queensland.

The accommodation and all events will be under the supervision of experienced adults.

Clothing will be casual wear but closed footwear will be essential. A formal standard of dress will be required for one evening during the week. Early July in Queensland is the middle of winter, with an average maximum temperature of 21C and an average minimum of 11C. All students need to be mindful of the cooler climate and bring appropriate clothing

Consumption of alcohol and smoking are not permitted at any time during Youth ANZAAS.

Registration will include the conference, all activities, accommodation, and all meals. Students will be met at Brisbane Airport and taken directly to the accommodation. They will similarly be returned to the Brisbane airport for their departure.

The cost will be \$A495-00 including GST.

Travel Arrangements

Students travelling from within Australia will travel by air from the capital cities. This cost will be covered with funding assistance from the federal Department of Education.

EACH STATE OR TERRITORY WILL SELECT, BY WHATEVER METHOD IS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE PARTICULAR DIVISIONAL COMMITTEE, NO MORE THAT SIX STUDENTS TO RECEIVE FREE TRAVEL TO YOUTH ANZAAS 2016.

The <u>minimum age</u> of the selected students <u>must be 16 on 9th July 2016</u> and all New Zealand students must be in possession of a valid passport with at least six months validity remaining on 10th July 2016.

STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO TRAVEL ONLY ON FLIGHTS ARRANGED BY ANZAAS AND THE PARENTS/GUARDIANS/AUTHORISED CARE-GIVERS OF THE SELECTED STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT REGARDING REFUND OF AIRFARES IN THE EVENT OF A "NO SHOW" FOR THE FLIGHTS.

The co-ordinating office in Australia will be the ANZAAS Office in Brisbane through which final travel arrangements will be made. The ANZAAS coordinator in 2016 is Professor Barry Noller and his contact details are listed below.
